- 1. Call meeting to order;**
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of our Country and State;**
- 3. Audience comments. Comments from the audience (for matters not on the agenda) this provides an opportunity to comment on non-agenda items in advance of the regular business of the Board of Directors. Comments shall be limited to three (3) minutes per person. By State law, comments by the President or Board members on any item not on the agenda shall be limited to:**
 - a. Statement of specific factual information given in response to any inquiry;
 - b. A recitation of existing policy in response to an inquiry;
 - c. A proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a future meeting;
- 4. Approve Board meeting minutes of April 14, 2021;**
- 5. Cybersecurity issues, and authorize appropriate action;**
- 6. Designate voting representative for Association of Water Board Bylaws Amendment Election;**
- 7. Conduct annual review and receive report on identity theft prevention program and adopt identity theft prevention program amendment, if appropriate;**
- 8. Conduct annual review of Drought Contingency Plan and authorize any necessary action;**
- 9. Approve purchase of a 2021 F150 for Wastewater Treatment Plant No. 1;**
- 10. Engineer's Report, including status of the following District projects and authorize any necessary action;**
 - a. Water Plant No. 6, Water Well No. 6 and 1.0 MGD Elevated Storage Tank;
 - b. Wastewater Plant No. 2 Phase I;
 - c. Water line replacement at Airport Road/FM 1092;
 - d. Wastewater Plant No. 1 Dewatering Improvements;
 - e. FM 1092 8-inch Sanitary Sewer Emergency Repair
 - f. Miscellaneous development repair and improvement projects;
 - g. General Engineering, development plats, consent to encroach agreements, facilities, annexations and development issues.

15. Discuss and take any necessary action related to the following construction contract; Surface Water Line & Brand Lane Water Plant GST Connection, including approve construction contracts with Prime Controls and Electrical Automation Controls, if appropriate;
16. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, a settlement offer, or other appropriate matters;
17. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer, or other matters considered in Executive Session;
