Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Water Control and Improvement District No. 2, of Fort Bend and Harris Counties, Texas, will hold a Regular Meeting, open to the public, on Wednesday the 10th day of December 2025, at 6:30 p.m., at the District Office, 2331 South Main, Stafford, Texas, within the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

5. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for the Association of Water Board Directors winter conference.
6. Review and update Eminent Domain Report to the Texas Comptroller.
7. Review and discuss amended Rate Order and authorize any necessary action.
8. Engineer's Report, including status of the following District projects and authorize any necessary action.
 - a. Surface Water Treatment Plant Expansion to 7.8 MGD Phase II;
 - b. Wastewater Treatment Plant No. 1 Improvements;
 - c. Staffordshire Road Waterline Extension;
 - d. Frances Site Work and Generator;
 - e. Miscellaneous development repair and improvement projects;
 - f. General Engineering, development plats, deeds, consent to encroach agreements, abandonments, easements, facilities, annexations, out-of-district service agreements, utility deeds, utility conveyances, utility commitment letters and development issues.
